We want to make sure that DA dancers and families are getting the classes they wish and that classes are not canceled due to lack of enrollment. Please state on the registration form what type of dance (ballet, tap, jazz, etc.) your dancer is interested in and what previous dance experience your dancer has had to help make placements as well. As mentioned above, your dancer will be placed in class(es) according to their classes from last season as well as their age and previous dance training. Class placement is not guaranteed if we do not receive your form and deposit(s) by the beginning of the dance season. Confirmation of your registration, class placement, and a tuition statement including any credit(s) that you may have from last season, will be emailed to you as soon as your registration is processed...usually in August. Our new website is up and running. There are registration links for Fall Registration, Nutcracker Auditions, Dance Alliance Repertory Auditions and of course all our Summer Workshops, Intensives and Camps.

We have truly enjoyed every year with our Dance Alliance dancers and families and we look forward to continuing to share our love for dance and all that it has to offer with all of you in the many seasons to come.
